## Consultations on Cobell Trust Land Consolidation

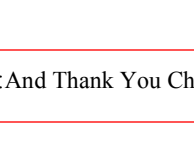
**Seattle Consultation – Sept 16, 2011**

The Cobell settlement was approved by Congress on November 30, 2010 (Claims Resolution Act of 2010) and signed by President Obama on December 8, 2010. The \$3.4 billion Cobell Settlement will address the Federal Government's responsibility for trust accounts and trust assets maintained by the United States on behalf of more than 300,000 individual Indians. A fund of \$1.5 billion will be used to compensate class members for their historical accounting, trust fund and asset mismanagement claims. In addition, to address the continued proliferation of thousands of new trust accounts caused by the "fractionation" of land interests through succeeding generations, the Settlement establishes a \$1.9 billion fund for the voluntary buy-back and consolidation of fractionated land interests. The land consolidation program will provide individual American Indians with an opportunity to obtain cash payments for divided land interests and free up the land for the benefit of tribal communities. Furthermore, up to \$60 million will be set aside to provide scholarships for higher education for American Indians and Alaska Natives.

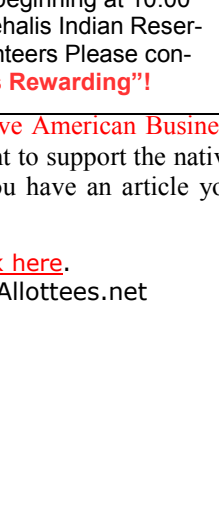
